NON-ATTENDANCE WILL COST YOU...

Did you know that as an OAG member, if you register for the Conference, and do not attend, your non-attendance costs the OAG approximately \$1,000 (hotel accommodation, breakfasts, lunches, dinners, nutrition breaks and administration.)? The OAG office is required to give guarantees to the venue at least five (5) business days prior to the start of any Conference. Therefore, if you do not cancel by the seven-day prior deadline, you are included in the hotel room count and meal numbers for the entire Conference. It is the fiduciary duty of the Board of Directors to ensure that the OAG's monies are spent wisely.

The OAG has implemented a policy for Conference delegates – it is mandatory that you provide a valid credit card number to register for the Conference and specific events. Your credit card will not be charged unless you do not attend and neglect to notify the OAG office by the cancellation deadline (as indicated on the registration form.) The amount that will be charged to your credit card is the fee for one night's hotel accommodation, administration and your meals – approximately \$1,000.

If you need to cancel your hotel reservation, Conference or event registration, please refer to the registration form and contact the OAG office - you will receive a cancellation number as your validation.

The Distinguished Service Award is given in recognition of a fellow gastroenterologist who has made an outstanding contribution in Gastroenterology.



DR. BRAIN FEAGAN, MD, FRCPC

Join us as we honour Dr. Brain Feagan with the OAG Distinguished Service Award.

Dr. Brian G. Feagan is Professor of Medicine, Epidemiology and Biostatistics, Division of General Internal Medicine at Western University (Formerly The University of Western Ontario), London, Ontario, Canada. He became the Director of Robarts Clinical Trials at the Robarts Research Institute in 1997 and in 2020, the Senior Scientific Director of Alimentiv Inc. (formerly Robarts Clinical Trials). He completed his medical degree at Western University. His postdoctoral training included a residency in internal medicine and a clinical fellowship in gastroenterology in the Department of Medicine at Western University, and postgraduate training in the Department of Epidemiology and Biostatistics at McMaster University, Hamilton, Ontario.

Dr. Feagan's research efforts focus on the design and implementation of randomized controlled trials of therapy for IBD. He has authored more than 500 articles and book chapters and has given over 1000 invited presentations at local, national, and international scientific meetings. He has also been the principal investigator on numerous large-scale randomized clinical trials.

A Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, Dr. Feagan holds membership in the Canadian and American Association of Gastroenterology, the American College of Gastroenterology, the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario, Crohn's and Colitis Canada (CCC), and the European Crohn's and Colitis Organization (ECCO).
